As a representative of the Cupertino Sanitary District (CuSD). We were notified by our District Counsel of the following new ruling:

The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) published a final rule updating Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). These regulations require all services, programs, and activities of state or local governments to be accessible to people with disabilities including public sector websites, online systems and digital resources. As part of the final rule, **the DOJ adopted Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA and incorporated them by reference into Title II.** Beginning in 2026, public agencies must “comply with both Level A and Level AA success criteria and conformance requirements specified in WCAG 2.1.” (28 CFR § 35.200(b).)
